








MOVING UP TOWN HAS NEVER BEEN EASIER

Enter the Maestro City and City X — generous family hatchbacks offering large-car spaciousness, comfort and economy at small-car prices.

The Maestro City is packed with the benefits of Maestro's advanced engineering. Specially designed to permit the low, aerodynamic bonnet line, the 'homofocal' halogen headlamps blend into white lamp indicators. The City comes fully equipped with a laminated windscreen, twin rear fog guard lamps, reversing lamps, a heated rear window, and a locking fuel filler flap. Twin door mirrors contribute to the superb all-round visibility. In the boot, valuables are protected by a folding rear parcel shelf.

The Maestro City's comfortable interior is fitted with distinctive Marle and Plain velour seat facings, and reclining front seats with head restraints. The soft feel colour-keyed seat belts offer adjustable upper mountings to suit taller people. The new-style fascia houses a push-button radio which plays through twin door-mounted speakers; and

features which include a dipping rear view mirror, intermittent wipe (in addition to the flick wipe facility), and a lockable glovebox have further enhanced the generous specification.

In fact, the only area where the Maestro City could be accused of meanness is with petrol — because at steady 56 mph it does over 50 mpg.

Distinguished by a stylish 3 bar coachline, the Maestro City X has the advantage of a microprocessor-controlled carburettor to give an additional boost to fuel economy. This reduces the engine idle speed, operates a deceleration fuel cut-off, and adjusts the cold-start mixture in no less than 150 precision steps. As a result, on the urban cycle the City X delivers a frugal 37.2 mpg. There are additions to comfort too, with a digital clock, full depth door trim and front door bins; useful features include a rear wash/ wipe which also features an intermittent facility. With both models, you can take up your options with a choice of black or clearcoat metallic paint, a radio/stereo cassette, and even a cellular mobile telephone (dealer fitted).

With a slender coachline bearing the distinctive Mayfair decal, a silver and chrome radiator grille and bright door mirror cappings, this model makes its entrance with style and panache. Central door locking lets you secure or open doors and tailgate with the minimum of fuss and bother.

Attractive full wheel trims, tinted glass and remote control door mirrors are all part of the specification.

Inside there's pure luxury, with Box and Plain velvet seat facings and head restraints, burr walnut door cappings, and a rear centre armrest. The top quality 3-band electronic tune stereo radio/stereo cassette player is linked to four speakers with a front/rear balance control. The instrumentation includes a tachometer, and is fitted with a panel light rheostat. And the electric front windows can be controlled at the touch of a button. Powerassisted steering, automatic





transmission and a slide and tilt steel sunroof are among the tempting list of options.

With the 1.6 S-Series engine driven through five-speed transmission, the fuel economy of the Maestro Mayfair is remarkable, returning 53.3 mpg at steady 56 mph. The acceleration — with a potential 10.5 seconds* from 0 to 60 — could cause a few raised evebrows too. eyebrows too.



COMMAND PERFORMANCE

It will give you virtuoso performance. Powered by the fuel-injected 2.0 O-Series engine, the MG Maestro EFi can reach 60 mph in only 8.5 seconds* and go racing on to a top speed of 115 mph* (where permissible). Developing 134 lb.ft. maximum torque at only 2800 rpm, the MG EFi also produces outstanding

acceleration in a high gear, taking a mere 6.3 seconds* to sprint from 30 to 50 mph in fourth.

The fuel injection system fitted to the MG incorporates electronic fuel control, and also an advanced programmed ignition system. Reacting to engine sensors, programmed ignition is capable of advancing or retarding the spark according to engine speed, temperature and load. The system caters far more effectively than a

mechanical timing system for the wide range of engine operating requirements. It also allows a relatively lean mixture to be used, and combines with electronic fuel control and fuelinjection to produce a rare combination of high performance with good economy.

A five-speed close ratio gearbox exploits the 117 PS (DIN) powerhouse. Up-rated suspension settings, a rear anti-roll bar and 14 in. alloy wheels

with low-profile tyres give the poise and balance for high-speed cornering. Ventilated front discs increase braking efficiency, and the deeper front spoiler combined with the tailgate spoiler fine tune the car's excellent aerodynamics.

Blending contemporary styling with sporting tradition, the door mirrors, door handles and unique style grille are keyed to the body colour, and there are slim MG-red inserts in the bumpers and bodyside

If you feel that it wouldn't take too much effort to become accustomed to such style — then it's time you were cruising in the flagship.







Turbo-charging has sent the power of the 2.0 litre O-Series engine soaring up to 152 PS (DIN), developing an awe-inspiring 169 ft.lb. maximum torque at 3500 rpm. 

Not only examples of the production cars, such as the beautiful 1907 20HP Tourer (similar to that which won the 1907 Tourist Trophy race) and from more recent times, the 1972 3.5 litre saloon used as Prime Minister Harold Wilson's official car; but also a fair proportion of the fascinating research cars, such as the gas turbine cars and the P6BS sports car prototype — a 140 mph mid-engined car of notably practical layout. Some

of the gas turbine cars are on long term loan to major museums. "JET 1", the world's first turbine powered car, takes pride of place in the South Kensington Science Museum in London, while the Coventry-based Museum of British Road Transport features the 1955 T3 four-wheel drive turbine coupe and the 1965 Rover-BRM Le Mans racing car.

For a wide selection of classic Rovers, a visit to the Heritage Motor Museum at Syon Park near Brentford, is strongly recommended — especially since the coupon here entitles you to a special offer. Why not come and see the constantly-changing display at the museum, along with all the other attractions of Syon Park, The Butterfly House, the Garden Centre, and of course the Park itself.
